MINUTES

Meeting Held 9/16/87

Minutes of the August 13, 1987 meeting were read and approved by all attending.

The status of the Workshop was discussed, and it was decided that the comment sheets would be Xeroxed and distributed to the members. There were many comments by the various members on the Workshop and what we could do to improve it the next year. There was a request for a financial statement.

The financial statement is in the process of being prepared. There are a few bills which are outstanding and which have some corrections to be made before the whole thing can be finalized.

Phyllis was again commended on the excellent job that she did and how well it was run and how good it was.



It was also mentioned that we might take under consideration having a 2-part workshop. One of the sections would be professional with people like Jim Brones and Betty Hahn or some of the Zone System photographers, and another section with the more contemporary photographers like Olivia and Jerry. These items will be finalized during the next meeting.

Abigail Adler, P. O. Box 1342, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504 came by and was interested in knowing how she could help promote the Council and the workshop.

The Willard Van Dyke Memorial Award had 30 applicants and 9 finalists and one clear winner. This is considered an excellent start with such little notice and preparation. The group decided that we would try to expand this effort to get off the ground early in next year so that we would get the proper publicity and coverage before and after the award was made. Also, there would be some possibly additional or broader coverage of the display of the winner's photograph.

Susan Streeper was discussed as a person who might join the Board as a Director. Since there was no quorum at this meeting, this item was not voted upon and will be discussed at a future meeting when there is a quorum.
