As required by law you will soon MX announce a/listof wilderness of study areas XX XXXXXXX XX million acres selected from nearly 1,500 totaling roadless areas/56 million acres. From the point of view of wilderness The inventory preservation this quantity is woefully inadequate. IX has been made hastily within the plast year and a half whereas the #XXXX should have been under way since the wilderness law was enacted. The apparent reason for not including more XXXX roadless land in the wilderness study areas is to permit XM its exploitation for logging. With the new policy of the Forest Service encouraging clear cutting, forests once logged in mountainous country where/erosion will ensue Kait not return to a productive condition for hundreds of years, if ever. The high rate of timber harvesting at present practiced is necessitated not by domestic consumption but to supply logs and lumber for Japan. This use is not to our best national interest.

For these reasons I believe that the entire 56 million acres of XXXXXXX de facto wilderness should be protected by wilderness classification as a reserve for the future and not be squandered for improvident immediate exploitation.
